Informed Consent

The Chapter of General Surgeons has deliberated on the process of obtaining an informed consent in the local context and practice, and to find ways to improve the process. The Board piloted a project in late 2011 where a risk assessment proforma was designed for each of the more common general surgical procedures. This pro-forma is intended as an aide memoire to be used as an adjunct to the informed consent process. The risk assessment proforma has been launched at the 5th Annual General Meeting on 16 May 2012. This project was also featured on the local print media. It was published in the Straits Times on 4 June 2012 titled "Better process for 'informed consent". These proforma have since been uploaded on the College of Surgeons website.

Dr Wong Soon Kuan gave a note of thanks to the committee for their work in getting the risk assessment proforma in place.

Exit Examination Preparatory Course 2012 for Advanced Surgical Trainees (ASTs) in General Surgery

The Chapter of General Surgeons had organized its 5th Exit Examination Preparatory Course from 26 to 29 June 2012 for the Advanced Surgical Trainees (ASTs) in General Surgery to help the ASTs in their preparations for their exit examinations. The preparatory course was hosted by the National University Hospital, Khoo Teck Puat Hospital, Singapore General Hospital, Changi General Hospital and Tan Tock Seng Hospital. The course comprised of bedside teaching and mock VIVA of similar format as the actual exit examinations and covered core modules such as Breast, Endocrine, Upper Gastrointestinal, Vascular, Trauma, Colorectal, Hepato-pancreato-biliary, General Surgery, Head & Neck, Minimally-Invasive Surgery and Emergency Surgery & Critical Care.

Based on the positive feedback received from the past four preparatory courses, the Chapter hopes to continue to organise this event for the benefit of the future batches of AST. The Chapter is however mindful that the course needs to be reviewed regularly and fine-tuned accordingly so as to stay relevant to the changes in the training curriculum. Dr Wong Soon Kuan gave a note of thanks to Dr Stephen Chang for his efforts as the Course Convenor for the successful course.
