## 2010 EXIT EXAMINATION FOR HAND SURGERY

The Chapter of Hand Surgeons had partaken the organising of the Hand Surgery exit examination that was conducted on Saturday, 28 August 2010 at the Singapore General Hospital for the clinical segment. By collaborating with the Joint Committee on Specialist Training (JCST), the Chapter had the opportunity to plan and organise part of the exit examination under the administration of the Chapter. Two candidates (all from Singapore) had scored a pass in this diet of the exit examination.

# **STAFF REGISTRAR SCHEME (SRS)**

With reference to the Ministry of Health's (MOH's) paper in early 2007 introducing the initiative of conducting a structured diploma programme with on-the-job training as previously proposed by the AMS for foreign doctors whose specialist degrees are not recognised by the Singapore Accreditation Board and whose medical schools are not recognised by the Singapore Medical Council, the Chapter had rolled out its SRS Programme in July 2008. There was no potential candidate for the SRS Diploma in Hand Surgery as at 2010. The SRS Programme will ultimately award a *Diploma in Hand Surgery* conferred jointly by the AMS and the College of Surgeons, Singapore (CSS).

#### **ENDORSEMENT OF EVENT**

The Chapter had supported the 19<sup>th</sup> Comprehensive Hand Review Course of the Singapore Society for Hand Surgery (SSHS) held from 5-6 March 2010 at the National University Hospital.

## PARTICIPATION IN MINISTRY OF HEALTH'S (MOH) INITIATIVES

All Specialty Chapters under the College of Surgeons, Singapore were invited by MOH through the Academy of Medicine, Singapore (AMS) to participate in the following:

# **Specific Licensing Conditions for Credentialling Medical Practitioners**

The review exercise called in June 2010 was intended to gather feedback on the specific licensing conditions to determine whether the proposed licensing conditions were adequate to ensure patient safety, and whether there were any additional conditions to be included.

## **Review of Framework & Categorization of Screening Tests**

The Screening Test Review Committee, formed by the Academy of Medicine and chaired by Prof Lee Hin Peng, was tasked to formulate a report on the recommendations and categorization of screening tests provided in Singapore. The objective was to develop a screening test framework and to make recommendations on the categorization of commercially available screening tests within the framework. Feedback was invited from all Specialty Chapters in June 2010 to assist in developing the screening test framework.

### **ACTIVITIES IN THE PIPELINE**

Combined Singapore Society for Hand Surgery (SSHS) and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Chapter of Hand Surgeons Dinner Lecture

The Chapter of Hand Surgeons is jointly organising the first combined dinner with SSHS which is to be held on Monday, 10 January 2011 at the Peach Garden @33. The Chapter will also be conducting its 2<sup>nd</sup> Lectureship by inviting Dr Marc Garcia-Elias from Institut Kaplan, Hand and Upper ExtremitySurgery, Barcelona, Spain who will speak on *Evolution of Wrist Instability Surgery: The Long and Winding Road.* In conjunction with the combined dinner lecture, the Memorandum of Understanding between the Chapter of Hand Surgeons and SSHS will also be signed to signify a formal and closer collaboration between the two bodies. Event information will be disseminated when available.

## 2011 Exit Examination for Hand Surgery

After the last successful collaboration with the JCST for the 2010 exit examination, the Chapter will continue to partake the organising of the 2011 exit examination by supplying the written paper and organising the clinical exam. The examination convenor for the clinical exam is Dr Tan Ter Chyan.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Hand & Wrist Arthroplasty Course

Jointly organized by the Chapter of Hand Surgeons and Tan Tock Seng Hospital, the 1<sup>st</sup> Hand & Wrist Arthroplasty Course is scheduled to be conducted from 22-23 September 2011 at Tan Tock Seng Hospital. This comprehensive course is packed with topical lecture series and cadaveric workshop with plenty of hands-on opportunities. The course will cover the highlights of Total Joint Arthroplasty, PIPJ, MCPJ, DRUJ, PRUJ.
