PARTICIPATION IN MINISTRY OF HEALTH'S INITIATIVES

Review of Levels of Medical Capability (LMC)

All Specialty Chapters under the College of Surgeons, Singapore were invited by the Ministry of Health through the Academy of Medicine, Singapore (AMS) in June 2009 to participate in the Review of Levels of Medical Capability (LMC) to provide feedback on the existing LMC manual on the medical capabilities at level 1 and 2 that are currently performed at regional hospitals versus teaching hospitals. Review and feedback included the following:

- 1. Proposed additional of new services or removal of obsolete services
- Proposed changes in terminology or description of services and/or changes in level of services
- 3. Identification of services which can only be performed under a tertiary setting
- 4. Identification of essential support services required for adequate provision of services

The Chapter of Paediatric Surgeons submitted its inputs to MOH through AMS in July 2009.
