7. The abstract should not be more than 300 words and include introduction, materials & methodology, results and conclusions.
8. Full registration fee should be paid before the abstract can be considered for inclusion in the book abstract.
9. Deadline for submission of abstracts (oral/poster) : **31st August 2009**
