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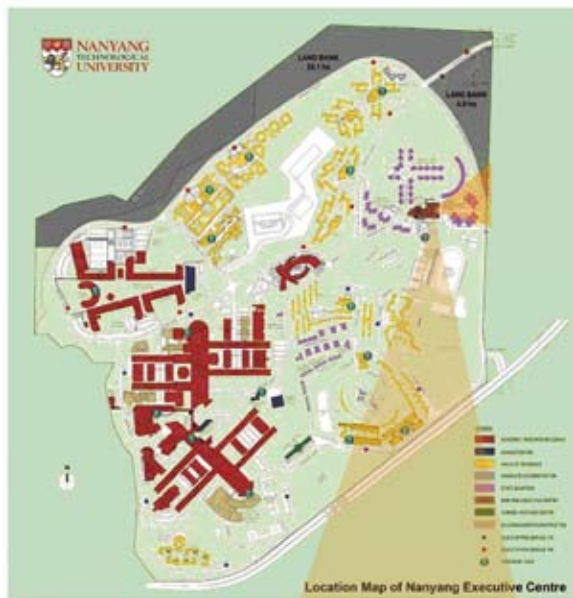

The Asian Australasian Advanced Course in Paediatric Neurosurgery (AAACPN) is the Asian Australasian equivalent of the European Course in Paediatric Neurosurgery, which has been successfully organised by the European Society for Paediatric Neurosurgery for over 20 years. A similar course has been started in Latin America since 2004. The 1st 3-year Cycle of the AAACPN was successfully completed in Australia, Japan and Korea from 2004-2006.

The 1st Part of the 2nd cycle of the AAACPN will be held in Singapore from 4-8 December 2007. If you are a neurosurgeon who wants to train to become a paediatric neurosurgeon or who has to look after paediatric patients in the course of your work, or if you are a neurosurgical trainee and want to learn more about paediatric neurosurgery and its practical nuances, this is the course for you.

The members of the teaching faculty are renowned paediatric neurosurgeons from Asia, Australia, Europe and the USA who have a passion for paediatric neurosurgery and are dedicated to training neurosurgeons to become competent paediatric neurosurgeons. This is especially important for the Asian region where the paediatric population is growing and where there is a great demand from children with neurosurgical diseases.

This course is a live-in 5-day programme in paediatric neurosurgery, comprising didactic lectures, case discussions, hands-on training and video teaching sessions, with many opportunities to mingle with faculty members and fellow attendees for learning, friendship and fellowship.
