The Chapter of Hand Surgeons conducts two workshops every year as part of its initiative towards resident education. The two workshops include a 'Cadaveric Workshop' and a 'Sawbone Workshop' that will be held at the beginning of each resident rotation (Jan/ Aug).

The workshops cater primarily to Hand Surgery residents and fellows in Singapore. They are also open to residents from other allied specialties like Orthopedic Surgery and Plastic Surgery on a first come-first serve basis.

This one day cadaveric workshop will allow residents to practice common as well as uncommon exposures, tendon repairs and ligament reconstruction using bone anchors. In addition the workshop has been designed to expose residents to infrequently perform but important surgical procedures.

PROGRAM
1) Surgical approaches to the finger
2) Flexor tendon repair - strategies, techniques and pitfalls
3) Extensor tendon repair
4) Palmaris longus tendon graft harvest and Pulvertaft weave technique
5) Thumb metacarpophalangeal joint ulnar collateral ligament repair
6) Flexor digitorum superficialis (FDS) opponensplasty
7) Extensor indicis proprius (EIP) to extensor pollicis longus (EPL) transfer
8) Trapeziectomy with ligament reconstruction and tendon interposition (LRTI)
9) Posterior interosseous nerve (PIN) harvest and wrist denervation
