# STAFF REGISTRAR SCHEME (SRS)

With reference to the Ministry of Health's (MOH's) paper in early 2007 introducing the initiative of conducting a structured diploma programme with on-the-job training as previously proposed by the Academy of Medicine, Singapore (AMS) for foreign doctors, the Chapter had implemented its SRS Programme in April 2008.

This is a three-year programme and the second intake has one (1) trainee currently and still ongoing until August 2015. The trainee in the SRS Programme will ultimately be awarded a Diploma in Cardiothoracic Surgery conferred jointly by the Academy of Medicine, Singapore (AMS) and the College of Surgeons, Singapore (CSS).
