STAFF REGISTRAR SCHEME (SRS)

The Ministry of Health (MOH) introduced in 2007 the initiative of conducting a structured diploma programme with on-the-job training as previously proposed by the Academy of Medicine, Singapore (AMS) for foreign doctors, the Chapter has rolled out the three-year programme SRS Programme since April 2008.

The successful participants of the SRS Programme will be awarded the *Diploma in Cardiothoracic Surgery* conferred jointly by the Academy of Medicine, Singapore (AMS) and the College of Surgeons, Singapore (CSS). In 2015, one trainee was accepted into the program and will complete the training by August 2018. In 2017, one trainee was accepted into the program and will complete the training by August 2020.

PILOT AMS SELF-LEARNING MODULES

The Chapter submitted their input of papers and MCQs for the specialty's SLM module with the Council, College of Surgeons, Singapore contributing to the general MCQs applicable across all surgical specialties.
