# **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

### DR LIEW WOEI KANG

My Council will continue to take care of the professional matters of our Fellows and represent their views through the Academy of Medicine, Singapore. I am particularly thankful for the support of my Council who has worked tirelessly to advance the interest of paediatricians in Singapore.



CPCHS Council has been very busy in 2018. One of our main activities is to plan regular CMEs for our Fellows, and we started a new theme of 'Hot Topics/ Advances in Various Paediatric Subspecialties'. Our education efforts culminated in the annual Singapore Paediatric and Perinatal Congress (SiPPAC) where we were the lead organiser in 2018. We experimented with getting various established paediatric subspecialties to be involved in the planning of the SiPPAC that held dedicated symposiums to gain subspecialty CME points. I am glad to report an overwhelming support from the local paediatricians at all our education events.

The Council launched some clinical guidelines, continuing the efforts initiated by A/Prof Marion Aw, the immediate past-president. We completed the

Growth Monitoring and Neonatal Jaundice guidelines, and are working on others including Nutrition, Allergy Testing and Allergy Prevention guidelines. There were also several professional opinions sought by Ministry of Health (MOH), including on the use of autologous cord blood for the treatment of cerebral palsy, epilepsy, autism and hypoxic-ischaemic encephalopathy. We also formed a workgroup to evaluate the use of codeine cough medications in children.

As we step into 2019, my Council will continue to take care of the professional matters of our Fellows and represent their views through the Academy of Medicine, Singapore. I am particularly thankful for the support of my Council who has worked tirelessly to advance the interest of paediatricians in Singapore.

# THE 7TH SINGAPORE PAEDIATRICS & PERINATAL ANNUAL CONGRESS (SIPPAC)

The 7th Singapore Paediatric & Perinatal Annual Congress (SiPPAC) 2018 was held from 27 to 28 July 2018 at Novotel Singapore on Stevens.

The theme was 'Paradigm Shifts in Paediatric Care'. This congress was organised by the College of Paediatrics and Child Health, Singapore with support from Perinatal Society of Singapore (PSS) and Singapore Paediatric Society (SPS). The event attracted close to 230 delegates comprising paediatricians, neonatologists, medical students, nurses, allied health staff, residents and trainees as well as overseas delegates.

The scientific programme comprised 11 symposia (Paediatric, Perinatal and Neonatal tracks), two nursing symposia, four lunch symposia and one oral presentation.

A total of 52 abstracts were accepted, of which eight were selected for Oral Presentations and eight were selected for Poster Presentations. A total of 36 abstracts were displayed on poster panels at the event. The prizes awarded are as follows.
