Dr Tan Min-Han is the Founding CEO and Medical Director of Lucence Diagnostics. Lucence is an international genomic medicine company with offices in Singapore, San Francisco, Hong Kong and Suzhou. The company provides physicians with advanced liquid biopsy testing for cancer screening and treatment selection.

Dr Tan is a trained medical oncologist and clinical cancer geneticist. He received his MBBS and PhD from National University of Singapore. He completed his cancer specialist training at National Cancer Centre Singapore, and pursued cancer genetics in the United States at Van Andel Research Institute and Cleveland Clinic. In 2011, Dr Tan joined the Agency for Science, Technology and Research (A*STAR) to lead the Laboratory of Systems Medicine. He subsequently founded Lucence in 2016 to commercialize the liquid biopsy technology his lab developed at A*STAR. Dr Tan is also a visiting consultant at the Division of Medical Oncology, National Cancer Centre Singapore, and a visiting scholar at the Faculty of Engineering, Waseda University, Japan.
