The Singapore Dental Council (SDC) announced in [its circular](#) that all registered dental practitioners (i.e. dentists and OHTs) are required to fulfil the mandatory on-line Ethics Self-Assessment Exercise (ESAE) for renewal of practising certificate (PC) from 2025 for dentists and 2026 for OHTs respectively.
