PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The College of Dental Surgeons, Singapore (CDSS), has launched the Ethical Self-Assessment Exercise (ESAE) modules and assessments for the entire dental profession. This Singapore Dental Council (SDC)-led initiative took the CDSS two years to bring to fruition, from conceptualisation to implementation. This important project aims to uphold and improve the ethical and professional standards for all practitioners.

We have also launched the Antibiotics Guidelines for the Dental Profession, a highly relevant manual for daily dental practice and a must-have guide for every dentist.

The CDSS continues to organise and conduct the Exit Dental Specialist Examinations for would-be specialists, as well as to organise professional education programmes for our Fellows. We also assist in the managing complaints cases from both Ministry of Health (MOH) and the SDC.

We are establishing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the MOH for the introduction of regular Clinical Practice Guidelines for the dental profession on a long-term basis

The CDSS continues to remain engaged and very relevant to the progress of the dental community.

Considerations in the Frail Older Adult Speaker: Dr

Madeleine Tan

Synopsis: Frailty is a geriatric syndrome that affects about 6% of community-dwelling older adults. A further 37% of older adults in the community



are considered pre-frail. The most significant impact of frailty on a person is the reduced ability to perform normal daily activities and their gradual loss of independence. In this talk, we will explore the relationship between frailty and oral health, and how this impacts prosthodontic decisions for our frail older patients across the frailty spectrum.

Speaker: A/Prof Zheng Lei

Synopsis: Microvascular free bone transfer using computer-aided surgery (CAS) has proved to be a very reliable solution for jaw reconstruction and yields superior functional outcomes. We concluded our clinical studies focusing on CAS integration with vascularized bone flaps such as the modified iliac flap and femur flap for maxillofacial reconstruction. We have developed a comprehensive workflow, and streamlined the utilization of in-house computer-aided design and computer-aided manufacturing processes, incorporating intraoral anastomosis microsurgery and supermicrosurgery in maxillofacial reconstruction. Our studies have conclusively highlighted that the combined approach of CAS with vascularized bone flap techniques in maxillofacial reconstruction is not only feasible but also instrumental in simplifying complex procedures. This integration has substantially improved the predictability and reproducibility of surgical outcomes and expanded the surgical scope, consistently leading to favourable results.

Synopsis: Peri-implantitis is a destructive inflammatory



disease affecting the hard and soft tissues surrounding dental implants. It is the primary reason for dental implant failure reported in longterm studies, with an estimated prevalence of 1 in 5 dental implants. Recent developments in peri-implantitis have focused on predicting risks, treatment modalities, and preventive strategies to address the growing concern of implant failure due to peri-implant complications. (Although a range of associated factors involving both dental and systemic conditions have been reported, there is a lack of uniformity and agreement correlating these.) To successfully manage peri-implantitis, it is important to understand how these factors together, including patient-specific come characteristics and implant-related factors, which create different pathways to disease in different individuals. This presentation aims to discuss recently published information on the prevention and management of peri-implantitis, as well as the disease pathogenesis process.
