Dr Tang is currently Medical Director, Asthma, Sleep Lung and Allergy Centre, SBCC Baby and Child Clinic and Visiting Senior Consultant at KK Women's and Children's Hospital.



Dr. Liew graduated from the National University of Singapore and obtained his specialist qualifications of Membership to the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health (United Kingdom) in 2003. Dr Liew was awarded the Health Manpower Development Programme Fellowship from the Ministry of Health and underwent advanced training in Paediatric Allergy and Immunology at the Royal Children's Hospital, Melbourne, Australia in 2007. Since returning to Singapore, Dr. Liew held the position of Consultant Paediatrician in the Allergy Service and Rheumatology & Immunology Service, Department of Paediatrics, KK Women's and Children's Hospital. He was also Adjunct Assistant Professor in Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School Singapore and Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, NUS. Dr Liew was awarded several research grants to pursue clinical research in paediatric anaphylaxis, drug allergy, primary immunodeficiencies and Kawasaki disease, and published widely.
