3. An acknowledgement of the receipt of the abstract will be sent to the presenting author by email upon submission via e-mail.
4. Presenting authors are expected to register and to present their abstracts at scientific sessions.
5. Abstracts will be published in the conference abstract book (CD-ROM version) only if the presenting author is registered with full payment by 30 April 2012.
